CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to the use of water perfected under the terms of Permit S-17167. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source. The specific limits and conditions of the use are listed below.

SOURCE OF WATER: CROOKED RIVER, A TRIBUTARY OF DESCHUTES RIVER

PURPOSE OR USE: SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 14.3 ACRES

RATE AND VOLUME: THE RATE AND VOLUME IS LIMITED TO 0.18 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND AND AN ANNUAL VOLUME OF 57.2 ACRE-FEET

DATE OF PRIORITY: JULY 23, 1946

The point of diversion is located as follows:

14 S	14 E	WM	22	NE NE	DIRECT DIVERSION NO. 47A - 1300 FEET SOUTH FROM NE CORNER, SECTION 22

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

Water use measurement conditions:

- A. The water user shall maintain the totalizing flow meters or measuring devices, as approved by the Director, in good working order, at the point of diversion.
- B. The water user shall allow the Watermaster access to the meters or measuring devices; provided however, where the metres or measuring devices are located within a private structure, the Watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.


**NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW**

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered July 26, 2019, at Special Order Volume 113, Page 771, approving Transfer Application T-11373, and together with 94474, supercedes a portion of Certificate 87331, State record of Water Right Certificates.
