CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

STATE OF OREGON
WATER RESOURCES DEPARTMENT

confirms the right to use the waters of the TUALATIN RIVER, a tributary of WILLAMETTE RIVER, for INSTREAM USE for conservation, maintenance and enhancement of aquatic and fish life, wildlife, fish and wildlife habitat, and other ecological values.

This right was perfected under Permit S-15038. The date of priority is AUGUST 4, 1941 plus one minute. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used, and shall not exceed 0.066 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion, from JUNE 22 THROUGH SEPTEMBER 30, further limited to an annual volume of 13.31 ACRE-FEET.

The description of the stream point in which flows are to be maintained is the location of the diversion authorized previously under Certificate 16677, as follows:

Water rights upstream of the original point of diversion shall not be subject to regulation for flows in excess of the quantities to which this instream water right is entitled at the original point of diversion.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled shall not exceed the quantity of water legally available at the original point of diversion.

The instream right established by this transfer shall replace a portion of instream water rights established pursuant to ORS 537.341 or 537.346 and shall be in addition to instream water rights established pursuant to ORS 537.346, 537.348 or 537.470, unless otherwise specified by a subsequent order establishing a new instream water right.

The right is subject to all other terms and conditions of Certificate 22570, and any related decree.

This certificate is issued to confirm an ALLOCATION OF CONSERVED WATER approved by an order of the Water Resources Director recorded in Special Order Volume 121, Page 465 approving Conserved Water Application CW-122. This Certificate together with the reduced rate remaining right and the conserved water under CW-122 supersedes Certificate 16677, State Record of Water Right Certificates.
