CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to the use of water perfected under the terms of Permit G-11061. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the well(s). The specific limits and conditions of the use are listed below.

SOURCE OF WATER: THREE WELLS IN THE FIFTEENMILE CREEK BASIN

PURPOSE OR USE: IRRIGATION OF 88.15 ACRES AND SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 4.25 ACRES

MAXIMUM RATE: 1.16 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND

DATE OF PRIORITY: MARCH 24, 1989

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

**NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW**

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of appropriation, together with that diverted at the original points of appropriation, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available from the original points of appropriation described as follows:

In the event of a request for change in point of appropriation, additional point of appropriation or repair of these wells, the quantity of water to be allowed, together with any other rights from these wells shall not exceed the capacity of these wells at time of perfection of this right.

The well shall be maintained in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works shall be equipped with a usable access port, and may also include an air line and pressure gauge adequate to determine water level elevation in the wells at all times. When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device and keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this right may result in action including, but not limited to, restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the right.

This right is for the beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer (water source) as the original points of appropriation.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF APPROPRIATION and PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered May 21, 2019, at Special Order Volume 113, Page 134, approving Transfer Application T-12710, supercedes Certificate 86059, State record of Water Right Certificates.
