## STATE OF OREGON COUNTY OF POLK CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

STATE OF OREGON
WATER RESOURCES DEPARTMENT

confirms the right to use the waters of the NORTH YAMHILL RIVER, tributary to the YAMHILL RIVER, for instream use for conservation, maintenance and enhancement of aquatic and fish life, wildlife, fish and wildlife habitat and other ecological values.

The right was perfected by Permits S-13491. The date of priority is FEBRUARY 21, 1939, plus one minute.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used, and shall not exceed 0.015 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (cfs), limited to an annual volume of 2.86 ACRE FEET, measured at the point of diversion from June 26 through September 30.

The description of the stream point in which flows are to be maintained is as follows:

At the authorized point of diversion previously authorized under Certificate 88102 located as follows:

At the specified stream point, the amount of water to which this right is entitled shall not exceed the quantity of water legally available at the original point of diversion. Stream channel losses and gains calculated based on available data and the use of water by senior appropriators will determine the amount of water to which this right is entitled downstream from the original point of diversion within the specified stream reach.

The instream right established by this conserved water application shall replace a portion of instream water rights established pursuant to ORS 537.341 or 537.346 and shall be in addition to instream water rights established pursuant to ORS 537.348 or 537.470 unless otherwise specified by a subsequent order establishing a new instream water right.

The right is subject to all other terms and conditions of Certificates 88102 and any related decree.

This certificate is issued to confirm an ALLOCATION OF CONSERVED WATER approved by an order of the Water Resources Director recorded in Special Order Volume 121, Page 115, approving Conserved Water Application CW-121. This Certificate, together with Certificate 95995 and the conserved water under CW-121, supersedes Certificates 88102.
