CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

H.B. HENDRICKS AND WM. H. WOODBURY
WALDO, OREGON

confirms the right to use the waters of WEST BRANCH ILLINOIS RIVER, a tributary of ILLINOIS RIVER for the purpose of irrigation and supplemental supply

This right was perfected under Permit 4471. The date of priority is February 17, 1920. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.665 cubic foot per second.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent in case of rotation.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:


