CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

GOLD CREST FRUIT CO.
GOLD HILL, OR 97525

confirms the right to use the waters of GALLS CREEK, a tributary to the ROGUE RIVER for IRRIGATION of 25.0 ACRES AND DOMESTIC USE.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Jackson County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 4, at Page 1. The date of priority is MARCH 1905.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.22 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The amount of water used for irrigation shall be limited to a diversion of 0.009 (1/110) of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.74 acre feet per acre for each are irrigated and an annual volume limitation of 93.38 acre-feet.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate describes that portion of water right Certificate 16212, State Record of Water Right Certificates, REDUCED IN RATE by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered October 22, 2021, finalizing Allocation of Conserved Water Application CW-120, recorded in Special Order Volume 121, Page 842. This Certificate together with Certificate 96022 supersedes Certificate 16212, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
