CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to the use of water perfected under the terms of Permit G-3775. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the well(s). The specific limits and conditions of the use are listed below.

SOURCE OF WATER: A WELL, A TRIBUTARY OF BURNT RIVER

PURPOSE OR USE: COMMERCIAL USE

MAXIMUM RATE AND VOLUME: 0.03 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND AND FURTHER LIMITED TO A TOTAL QUANTITY OF WATER DIVERTED OF 7.5 ACRE-FEET

PERIOD OF USE: APRIL 1 THROUGH OCTOBER 1

DATE OF PRIORITY: AUGUST 4, 1967

Water use measurement conditions:

- A. The water user shall maintain the totalizing flow meter or other suitable measuring device as approved by the Director in good working order at each point of appropriation.
- B. The water user shall allow the watermaster access to the meter or measuring device; provided however, where the meter or measuring device is located within a private structure, the watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

This right shall be limited to appropriation of water only to the extent that it does not impair or substantially interfere with existing surface water rights of others.

This right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.

This certificate is issued to confirm changes in PLACE OF USE and CHARACTER OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered OCTOBER 15, 2020, at Special Order Volume 117, Page 738, approving Transfer Application T-13285, and together with Certificate 95120, supersedes Certificate 42462, State Record of Water Right Certificates.
