CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to the use of water perfected under the terms of Permit S-17966. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the point(s) of diversion from the source. The specific limits and conditions of the use are listed below.

SOURCE OF WATER: LITTLE ROCK CREEK, A TRIBUTARY OF WEST FORK ILLINOIS RIVER

PURPOSE OR USE: DOMESTIC USE

MAXIMUM RATE: 0.005 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND

PERIOD OF USE: YEAR ROUND

DATE OF PRIORITY: SEPTEMBER 23, 1947

The point of diversion is located as follows:

A description of the place of use is as follows:

The quantity of water diverted at the point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of diversion described as follows:

40 S	9 W	WM	27	NE SE	230 FEET SOUTH AND 420 FEET WEST FROM E1/4 CORNER, SECTION 27

Water use measurement conditions:

- A. The water user shall maintain, in good working order, a totalizing flow meter or other suitable measuring device as approved by the Director, at each point of diversion.
- B. The water user shall allow the watermaster access to the meter or measuring device; provided however, where the meter or measuring device is located within a private structure, the watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW


This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The water user shall operate and maintain the fish screen at the point of diversion consistent with Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife operational and maintenance standards. If ODFW determines a screen is not functioning properly, and is unsuccessful in working with the water user to meet ODFW standards, ODFW may request that Oregon Water Resources Department (OWRD) regulate the use of water until OWRD receives notification from ODFW that the fish screen is functioning properly.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the place of use described.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION, PLACE OF USE AND CHARACTER OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered September 15, 2015, at Special Order Volume 96, Page 901, approving Transfer Application 11628, and together with Certificate 90754, supercedes Certificate 20977, State record of Water Right Certificates.
