CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

TOUVELLE BIRD AND WATERFOWL REFUGE  
2980 CRATER LAKE HWY  
MEDFORD OR 97504

confirms the right to use the waters of ROGUE RIVER, A TRIBUTARY OF PACIFIC OCEAN for POND MAINTENANCE.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Jackson County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 16, at Page 523. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 22, 1888.

The use is limited to 0.894 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source, AND SHALL BE FURTHER LIMITED TO A DIVERSION OF NOT TO EXCEED 321.53 ACRE-FEET DURING THE IRRIGATION SEASON BEING APRIL 1 TO OCTOBER 31 OF EACH YEAR.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

**NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW**

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The types and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

The right to the use of the use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in PLACE OF USE AND CHARACTER OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered APRIL 4, 2003, at Special Order Volume 57, Page 337, approving Transfer Application 8622, and together with Certificate 79985, supersedes Certificate 65148, State record of Water Right Certificates.
