CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

STATE OF OREGON  
WATER RESOURCES DEPARTMENT

confirms the right to use the waters of the NORTH FORK GREEN POINT CREEK, tributary to HOOD RIVER, for instream use for conservation, maintenance and enhancement of aquatic and fish life, wildlife, fish and wildlife habitat and other ecological values.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Hood River County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 17, at Page 333. The date of priority is DECEMBER 1, 1905, *plus one minute*.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used, and shall not exceed 1.50 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND; or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion, from June 3 through September 30 further limited to an annual volume of 357.0 ACRE-FEET.

The description of the stream reach in which flows are to be maintained is as follows:

From the authorized point of diversion under Certificate 95432 from North Fork Green Point Creek located as follows:

To the confluence with Green Point Creek located in the NENW of Section 10, Township 1 North, Range 9 East, W.M., then protected in Green Point Creek to the mouth at the confluence with the West Fork of Hood River located in the SENW of Section 12, Township 1 North, Range 9 East, W.M.

**NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW**

This is final order is subject to judicial review by the Court of Appeals under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482(1). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

Water rights upstream of the original point of diversion shall not be subject to regulation for flows in excess of the quantities to which this instream water right is entitled at the original point of diversion.


This instream right shall replace a portion of instream water rights established pursuant to ORS 537.341 or 537.346 and shall be in addition to instream water rights established pursuant to ORS 537.348 or 537.470 unless otherwise specified by a subsequent order establishing a new instream water right.

The right is subject to all other terms and conditions of Certificate 95432, and any related decree.

This Certificate is issued to confirm an ALLOCATION OF CONSERVED WATER approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered March 7, 2022, finalizing Allocation of Conserved Water Application CW-92, recorded in Special Order Volume 122, Page 523.

This Certificate together with 96113 supercedes Certificate 95432, State Record of Water Resources.
