CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

SUNRIVER WATER LLC
PO BOX 3699
SUNRIVER OR 97707

confirms the right to use the waters of FOUR WELLS in the DESCHUTES RIVER BASIN for QUASI-MUNICIPAL USE.

This right was perfected under Permit G-3810. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 5, 1967. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 2.30 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the points of appropriation.

The points of appropriation are located as follows:

A description of the place of use is as follows:

WITHIN THE SERVICE BOUNDARIES OF SUNRIVER WATER LLC

Water use measurement conditions:

- A. The water user shall maintain the totalizing flow meters or other suitable measuring devices as approved by the Director in good working order at each point of appropriation.
- B. The water user shall allow the Watermaster access to the meters or measuring devices; provided however, where the meters or measuring devices are located within a private structure, the Watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

The quantity of water diverted at the additional points of appropriation, together with that diverted at the original point of appropriation, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of appropriation.

Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer (water source) as the original point of appropriation.


NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described; however, water may be applied to lands which are not specifically described above, provided the holder of this right complies with ORS 540.510(3).

This certificate is issued to confirm changes in ADDITIONAL POINTS OF APPROPRIATION and PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered MARCH 30, 2015, at Special Order Volume 95, Page 362, approving Transfer Application T-11672, and supersedes Certificate 88801, State Record of Water Right Certificates.
