CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

PAUL D. GREEN 837 WILLAMETTE ST EUGENE OR 97401

confirms the right to use the waters of MIDDLE FORK WILLAMETTE RIVER, RATTLESNAKE CREEK, ALDER CREEK A TRIBUTARY TO WILLAMETTE RIVER, for IRRIGATION of 32.6 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-16729. The date of priority is DECEMBER 24, 1945. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.41 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (CFS) BEING 0.14 CFS FROM Willamette River, 0.14 cfs from Rattlesnake Creek, and 0.13 cfs from Alder Creek, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

This is a final order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.
