CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

Has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to store the waters of ALDER CREEK SPRINGS AND MIDDLE FORK WILLAMETTE RIVER, tributary of WILLAMETTE RIVER, appropriated under Application 32922, Permit 25983

For the purposes of IRRIGATION and FISH POND under Reservoir Permit No. R-2220 of the State Engineer, and that said right to store said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from February 18, 1959.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled to be stored each year under such right for the purposes aforesaid, shall not exceed 8.9 ACRE-FEET.


