CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

Has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of MIDDLE FORK WILLAMETTE RIVER, ALDER CREEK, AND GREEN'S RESERVOIR constructed under application number R-32921, Permit number R-2220, a tributary of WILLAMETTE RIVER for the purpose of IRRIGATION of 4 ACRES and FISH CULTURE.

Under Permit S-25983 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from FEBRUARY 18, 1959. That the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.55 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (cfs), being 0.05 cfs for irrigation and 0.50 cfs for fish culture, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed, 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoir constructed under Permit R-2220, water to be diverted from Alder Creek when available and any deficiency in the available supply in Alder Creek is to be made up by diversion from Middle Fork Willamette River, providing that the total quantity diverted from both streams shall not

This is a final order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

exceed one-eighth of a cubic foot per second for each acre irrigated, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.


