 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of NORTH FORK DEER CREEK AND RESERVOIR CONSTRUCTED UNDER PERMIT R-1918, A TRIBUTARY OF SOUTH UMPQUA RIVER for MAINTENANCE OF A MULTI-PURPOSE RESERVOIR AND WETLAND ENHANCEMENT.

This right was perfected under Permit S-29347. The date of priority is NOVEMBER 18, 1963. The amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.75 cubic foot per second (cfs), and shall be further limited to the deficiency in the available supply in Livingston Creek under a prior right for the same purpose; The right to use of direct flow is limited to the period when the flow of the South Umpqua River is more than 60 cfs at its mouth, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.


Water use measurement conditions:

- A. The water user shall maintain, in good working order, a staff gauge or other suitable measuring device as approved by the Director at each point of diversion.
- B. The water user shall allow the Watermaster access to the meters or measuring devices; provided however, where the meters or measuring devices are located within a private structure, the Watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

The right to the use of the water for the above purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in CHARACTER OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered JANUARY 5, 2021, at Special Order Volume 118, Page 287, approving Transfer Application T-12596, supersedes Certificate 33596, State Record of Water Right Certificates.
