CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

MARIE FLORA
ROUTE 2, BOX 96
CANBY, OR

confirms the right to use the waters of GRIBBLE CREEK, a tributary of MOLALLA RIVER for IRRIGATION of 2.1 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-23161. The date of priority is AUGUST 19, 1954. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.026 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 ½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:



This certificate is issued in accordance with OAR 690-380-6010 to describe the water right for a non-completed change in point of diversion approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered April 25, 2001, at Special Order Volume 55, Page 388, approving Transfer Application T-8598 and supersedes Certificate 26649, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
