confirms the right to the use of water perfected under the terms of Permit G-9313. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the well. The specific limits and conditions of the use are listed below.

SOURCE OF WATER: TWO WELLS IN THE FORT ROCK BASIN

PURPOSE OR USE: IRRIGATING 122.1 ACRES

MAXIMUM RATE: 1.53 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND (CFS); BEING 1.5 CFS FOR THE IRRIGATION OF 120 ACRES LOCATED IN TOWNSHIP 26 SOUTH, RANGE 16 EAST, SECTION 34, AND 0.03 CFS FOR THE IRRIGATION OF 2.1 ACRES LOCATED IN TOWNSHIP 27 SOUTH, RANGE 17 EAST, SECTION 15, OR ITS EQUIVALENT IN CASE OF ROTATION MEASURED AT THE WELLS

DATE OF PRIORITY: MARCH 9, 1981

The wells are located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

**NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW**

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under this right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of appropriation, together with that diverted at the original point of appropriation, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available from the original point of appropriation described as follows:

28 S	16 E	WM	3	NW SE	1325 FEET NORTH AND 1360 FEET WEST FROM SE CORNER, SECTION 3

Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer (water source) as the original point of appropriation.


The water user shall maintain an in-line flow meter or other suitable device, as approved by the Department, for measuring and recording the quantity of water appropriated.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF APPROPRIATION and PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered November 18, 2005, at Special Order Volume 67, Page 445, approving Transfer Application T-9646, and together with Certificate 80649, supercedes Certificate 62488, State record of Water Right Certificates.
