## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of A WELL, a tributary of ROCK CREEK (PUDDING RIVER) for IRRIGATION of 1.86 ACRES.

This right was developed under Permit No. G-5687. The date of priority is MARCH 10, 1975, and the amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed Three acre feet per acre in any irrigation season, diverted at a rate of not to exceed 0.02 cubic foot per second or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

This certificate is issued in accordance with OAR 690-380-6010 to describe the water right for a non-completed change in point of appropriation approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered November 28, 2005, at Special Order Volume 67, Page 468, approving Transfer Application T-8156 and supersedes Certificate 6149, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described, and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
