CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of CLEAR CREEK, tributary of PINE CREEK, for TRACT NOS. 1 and 2, for IRRIGATION of 54.0 ACRES, DOMESTIC and STOCK USE for TRACT NOS. 1 and 2.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Baker County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 11, at Page 235. The date of priority is 1870 for TRACT NO. 1 and 1910 for TRACT NO. 2.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed ONE-FORTIETH OF A CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND PER ACRE, MEASURED AT THE POINT OF DIVERSION AND A TOTAL LIMITATION OF ONE ACRE-FOOT PER ACRE DURING JULY, ONE ACRE-FOOT PER ACRE DURING AUGUST, AND ONE-HALF ACRE-FOOT PER ACRE DURING SEPTEMBER, OF EACH YEAR.

The additional point of diversion is located as follows:


This is a final order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

Prior to October 1, 2023, the water user shall install and maintain a weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted at each new point of diversion. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

Prior to October 1, 2023, the water user shall install and maintain a fish screen or fish by-pass device, as appropriate, at the new point of diversion. The type and plans of the screen or by-pass device must be approved by the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife prior to beginning of construction, and shall be installed under the supervision of the Department of Fish and Wildlife.

This certificate is issued to confirm an HISTORIC CHANGE IN POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered APR 05 2022 approving Transfer Application T- 13444, and supersedes Certificate 10437, State Record of Water Right Certificates.
