confirms the right to use the waters of O'BRIEN and STURGIS FORKS of CARBERRY FORK of APPLGATE RIVER, a tributary of APPLGATE RIVER, for DOMESTIC, STOCK, AND IRRIGATION OF 9.34 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Jackson County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 16, at Page 523. The date of priority is 1857 for 0.02 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (CFS) and 1906 for 0.06 CFS; that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.08 CFS.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

(Note: To the extent of 9.34 acres in SWNE said Sec. 7, the foregoing right is supplemental to the vested right allowed claimants to the use of water from Thompson Creek which is set out in the Rogue River Decree on Page 34, Column 1, under Proof 1020.

It is also supplemental to the vested right allowed claimants to the use of water from Darniel Gulch which is set out in the Rogue River Decree on Page 34, Column 2, under Proof 1026.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The supplemental right allowed herein is limited to the use on the land to which it is appurtenant in an amount not exceeding 0.0094 cubic foot per second of water for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season, and the quantity used from all sources shall not exceed 0.02 cubic foot per second of water for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season.

Water use measurement conditions:

- A. The water user shall maintain the totalizing flow meter or other suitable measuring device as approved by the Director in good working order at each point of diversion.
- B. The water user shall allow the Watermaster access to the meter or measuring device; provided however, where the meters or measuring devices are located within a private structure, the Watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original points of diversion described as follows:



The water user shall operate and maintain the fish screen at the new point of diversion consistent with Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife (ODFW) operational and maintenance standards. If ODFW determines the screen is not functioning properly, and is unsuccessful in working with the water user to meet ODFW standards, ODFW may request that OWRD regulate the use of water until OWRD receives notification from ODFW that the fish screen is functioning properly.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in the decree.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered SEPTEMBER 21, 2017, at Special Order Volume 105, Page 812, approving Transfer Application T-12477, and together with Certificate 93250, supersedes Certificate 32290, State Record of Water Right Certificates.
