This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Josephine County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 4, at Page 1. The date of priority is 1891 for TRACT NO. 1, and JUNE, 1873 for TRACT NO. 2.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.03 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (CFS) for TRACT NO. 1, and 0.57 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND for TRACT NO. 2.
