CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That GLENDALE LUMBER COMPANY,

of Glendale, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of
the waters of Bear Creek, Woods Creek and North Fork Windy Creek, tributaries of
Windy Creek, and Windy Creek,
for the purpose of General sawmill purposes including domestic use

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Douglas County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order
Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 11, at page 1; that the priority
of the right thereby confirmed dates from May 10, 1893;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 12.0 cubic feet per
second.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant
(or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

PLACE OF USE:

NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 23, and
SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 33,
Twp. 32 South, Range 6 West, W.M.

*Change in point of div. and
place of use. Sp. Cr. 464, p. 270*

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations
contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place
of use herein described.
