CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

W. O. MINOR HEPPNER OR 97836

confirms the right to use the waters of WILLOW CREEK, a tributary to the COLUMBIA RIVER, in Morrow County, for the purpose of IRRIGATION (during the irrigation season) of 6.5 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Morrow County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 1, at Page 73. The dates of priority are MARCH, 1894 FOR THE IRRIGATION OF 5.4 ACRES AND 1908 FOR THE IRRIGATION OF 1.1 ACRES.

The amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the purpose aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purpose, and shall not exceed 0.09 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (CFS) AS OF DATE MARCH, 1894 AND 0.018 CFS AS OF DATE 1908.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows:

This certificate is issued in accordance with OAR 690-380-6100(6) to describe the water right for a non-completed change in additional point of diversion approved by an order of the Water Resources Director, entered NOVEMBER 21, 2001, at Special Order Volume 55, Page 1212, approving Transfer Application T-6754, and together with Certificates 78514 and 90407, supersedes Certificate 170, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
