confirms the right to the use of water perfected under the terms of Permit G-5953. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the well(s). The specific limits and conditions of the use are listed below.

SOURCE OF WATER: DEEP WELL NO. 2 AND HILLVIEW WELL NO. 4, IN THE JUNIPER CANYON BASIN PURPOSE OR USE: IRRIGATION OF 4.65 ACRES AND SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 15.0 ACRES

MAXIMUM RATE: 0.25 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (CFS); IN ANY COMBINATION, BEING NO MORE THAN

0.12 CFS FROM DEEP WELL NO. 2 AND 0.25 CFS FROM HILLVIEW WELL NO. 4

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. The right shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Water use measurement conditions:

- A. The water user shall maintain the totalizing flow meters or measuring devices, as approved by the Director, in good working order, at each point of appropriation, (new and existing).
- B. The water user shall allow the Watermaster access to the meters or measuring devices; provided however, where the meters or measuring devices are located within a private structure, the Watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

Water shall be acquired from the same aquifers (water source) as the original point of appropriation.

The water user shall maintain an in-line flow meters or other suitable devices for measuring and recording the quantity of water appropriated.

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of appropriation, together with that diverted at the original point of appropriation, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of appropriation.

The right to the use of water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered August 3, 2017, at Special Order Volume 105, Page 558, approving Transfer Application T-12397, and together with Certificate 93290, supercedes Certificate 86391, State record of Water Right Certificates.
