 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of NEIL CREEK, TRIBUTARY OF BEAR CREEK for IRRIGATION of 0.4 ACRE.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Jackson County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 4, at Page 1. The date of priority is 1854.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.005 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

A description of the place of use is as follows:

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of diversion described as follows:

Water use measurement conditions:

- A. The water user shall maintain the totalizing flow meter or measuring device, as approved by the Director, in good working order, at each point of diversion.
- B. The water user shall allow the Watermaster access to the meter or measuring device; provided however, where the meter or measuring device are located within a private structure, the Watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

The water user shall maintain and operate the fish screen at the new point of diversion consistent with Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife's operational and maintenance standards.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

Said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered June 25, 2019, at Special Order Volume 113, Page 446, approving Transfer Application T-12947, supercedes Certificate 54030, State record of Water Right Certificates.
