CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

STATE OF OREGON  
WATER RESOURCES DEPARTMENT

confirms the right to use the waters of Little Butte Creek, for instream use for conservation, maintenance and enhancement of aquatic and fish life, wildlife, fish and wildlife habitat and other ecological values.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Jackson County. The date of priority is 1872. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially and shall not exceed 6.63 Cubic Feet per Second (CFS) from April 1 through October 31 and 8.4 CFS from November 1 through March 31 of each year, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The description of the stream reach in which flows are to be maintained is as follows:

**Instream Point:** At the POD (as described below)

The instream right established by this transfer shall replace a portion of instream water rights established pursuant to ORS 537.341 or 537.346 and shall be in addition to instream water rights established pursuant to ORS 537.348 or 537.470, unless otherwise specified by a subsequent order establishing a new instream water right.


The right is subject to all other terms and conditions of Certificate 86767, and any related decree.

This final order is subject to judicial review by the Court of Appeals under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482(1). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in use and place of use approved by an order of the Water Resources Director recorded in Special Order Volume 125, Page 1038, approving Transfer T-13920, and along with Certificate 96389 supersedes Certificate 86767, State Record of Water Right Certificates.
