CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of LITTLE BUTTE CREEK for IRRIGATION of 40 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Jackson County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 14, at Page 498. The date of priority is 1884.

That the amount of water to which this right is entitled, for purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes and shall not exceed 1.0 cubic foot per second; measured at the head of the ditch or the point where the same leaves the natural stream, from April 1st to October 1st of each year, or its equivalent in case of rotation.

The water user shall maintain and operate a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted as required by the Department.

Water shall be acquired from the same surface water source as the original point of diversion.

The water user shall maintain and operate fish screening as required by the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

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And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.

This certificate is issued to confirm an ADDITIONAL POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered January 15, 2004, at Special Order Volume 59, Page 82, approving Transfer Application T-8916, Certificate 17201, State record of Water Right Certificates.
