CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

(For rights perfected under reservoir permits)

This is to Certify, That the CITY OF COQUILLE of Coquille, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE WATER BOARD of Oregon, of a right to store the waters of North and South forks of Rink Creek, Tributary of Coquille River for the purposes of general municipal supply for the City of Coquille, Coos County, Oregon.

under Reservoir Permit No. 17 of the State Engineer, and that said right to store said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon and duly confirmed by order of the STATE WATER BOARD of Oregon, made and entered of record in the Record of Proceedings of said Board, at Salem, in Volume 1, at page 191, on the 1st day of September, 1915; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from October 19, 1909

that the amount of water entitled to be stored each year under such right, for the purposes aforesaid, shall not exceed 27 acre feet. Reservoir No. 1 is located in the SE 1/4 of SW 1/4 of Section 4; Reservoir No. 2 is located in SE 1/4 of NE 1/4, Section 5 and settling basin or storage. ~~Reservoir~~ reservoir is located in Section 6, all in T. 28 S. R. 12 W., W. M.
