CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That LYSTOL-LAWSON LUMBER COMPANY,

of Glendale, , State of Oregon, has a right to the use of
 the waters of Tunnel Creek, tributary of Cow Creek, and Cow Creek,
 for the purpose of Sawmilling purposes,

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
 Douglas County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order
 Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 11, at page 1; that the priority
 of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1907;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
 amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 2.0 cubic feet per
 second of time.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant
 (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

PLACE OF USE: The W $\frac{1}{2}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$,
 Section 4;
 Twp. 33 South, Range 6 West, W.M.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations
 contained in said Decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place
 of use herein described.
