CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

THELMA C. RUMSEY
 STAR RT.
 SILVER LAKE, OR 97638

confirms the right to use the waters of A WELL, a tributary of FORT ROCK BASIN for IRRIGATION of 60.26 ACRES and SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION of 42.79 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-6957. The date of priority is AUGUST 9, 1976. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 1.29 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the well.

The well is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:


