 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of WILLOW CREEK, a tributary of the COLUMBIA RIVER for IRRIGATION of 1.5 ACRE.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Morrow County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 1, at Page 73. The date of priority is 1890.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.025 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-SIXTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season March 1 to September 1 of each year.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

**NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW**


This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

This certificate is issued in accordance with OAR 690-380-6100(6) to describe the water right for a non-completed change in additional point of diversion approved by an order of the Water Resources Director, entered March 6, 2017, at Special Order Volume 104, Page 37, approving Transfer Application T-11699, and together with Certificate 96671, supersedes Certificate 80055, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
