confirms the right to use the waters of HURRICANE CREEK, a tributary to WALLOWA RIVER for IRRIGATION of 28.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-28430. The date of priority is JANUARY 28, 1963. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.70 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion are located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year; provided further that the right to use of water is limited to the period when the flow of the Lower Grande Ronde River is more than 300 c.f.s. at USGS Gage No. 3325; and more than 420 c.f.s. at Oregon-Washington border; and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
