The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

- B. The water user shall allow the Watermaster access to the meters or measuring devices; provided however, where the meters or measuring devices are located within a private structure, the Watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

The quantity of water diverted at the new points of appropriation (L-125280, L-125281, L-104459, L-115916, L-111748, L-115909, and L-125022), shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of appropriation (Well 5) described as follows:

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINTS OF APPROPRIATION AND PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered JANUARY 15, 2020, at Special Order Volume 114, Page 892, approving Transfer Application T-12972, and together with Certificate 94703, supersedes Certificate 63600, State Record of Water Right Certificates.
