CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of WEST FORK DAIRY CREEK, a tributary of DAIRY CREEK to IRRIGATION of 22.8 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-35015.

The date of priority is MARCH 19, 1970.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.28 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

2 N	4 W	WM	14	NW SE	700 FEET SOUTH AND 2430 FEET WEST FROM THE E1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 14

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year: and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:


