confirms the right to the use of water perfected under the terms of Permit G-10099. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the well(s). The specific limits and conditions of the use are listed below.

SOURCE OF WATER: A WELL IN THE CHRISTMAS VALLEY BASIN

PURPOSE OR USE: IRRIGATION OF 20.8 ACRES

MAXIMUM RATE: 0.26 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND

DATE OF PRIORITY: APRIL 27, 1983

The well is located as follows:

26 S	16 E	WM	34	SE NE	20 FEET NORTH AND 60 FEET WEST FROM E1/4 CORNER, SECTION 34

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer (water source) as the original point of appropriation.


The water user shall maintain an in-line flow meter or other suitable measuring device for measuring and recording the quantity of water appropriated. The water user shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

The well shall be maintained in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the place of use described.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF APPROPRIATION and PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered June 8, 2007, at Special Order Volume 72, Page 277, approving Transfer Application T-9388, and together with Certificate 83291, supercedes Certificate 76578, State record of Water Right Certificates.
