confirms the right to the use of water perfected under the terms of Permit G-9141. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the well(s). The specific limits and conditions of the use are listed below.

SOURCE OF WATER: TWO WELLS IN FORT ROCK VALLEY BASIN

PURPOSE OR USE: IRRIGATION OF 21.5 ACRES

MAXIMUM RATE: 0.269 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND

DATE OF PRIORITY: AUGUST 13, 1980

The wells are located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

**NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW**

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The quantity of water diverted at the new point(s) of appropriation (wells), shall not exceed the quantity of water available from the original point(s) of appropriation described as follows:

Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer (water source) as the original point of appropriation.


The water user shall maintain an in-line flow meter or other suitable measuring and recording the quantity of water appropriated.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the place of use described.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF APPROPRIATION AND PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered June 8, 2007, at Special Order Volume 72, Page 277, approving Transfer Application T-9388, and together with Certificate 83292, supercedes Certificate 76671, State record of Water Right Certificates.
