The amount of water used for irrigation under, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

Water use measurement conditions:

- A. The water user shall maintain the totalizing flow meter or other measuring devices, as approved by the Director, in good working order, at each point of diversion (new and existing)
- B. The water user shall allow the Watermaster access to meters or measuring devices; provided however, where the meters or measuring devices is located within a private structure, the watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes of aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered May 30, 2022, at Special Order Volume 122 Page 663, approving Transfer Application T-13692, and together with Certificate 95879, supercedes Certificate 36859, State record of Water Right Certificates.
