CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That FRED E. VERRY, and T. A. VERRY,

of Armington, State of Illinois, has a right to the use of
the waters of Rail Creek,
for the purpose of Domestic supply,

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Douglas County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order
Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 11, at page 1; that the priority
of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1907;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, ~~and shall not exceed~~

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant
(or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

PLACE OF USE: Sections 28, 29, 32 and 33,
Twp. 30 South, Range 6 West, W.M.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations
contained in said Decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place
of use herein described.
