For irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year; provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein.

Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

## Water use measurement conditions:

- A. The water user shall maintain the totalizing flow meters or another suitable measuring devices as approved by the Director in good working order at each point of appropriation (new and existing).
- B. The water user shall allow the Watermaster access to the meters or measuring devices; provided however, where the meters or measuring devices are located within a private structure, the watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

The quantity of water diverted at the additional points of appropriation (Well #1 Upper Dam Well, Well #4 Stock Well, Well #7 Corral Well, and Well #8 Lower Dam Well), together with that diverted at the original point of appropriation (Well #2 Middle Well), shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of appropriation (Well #2 Middle Well).

Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer (water source) as the original point of appropriation.

The well shall be cased as necessary in accordance with good practice and if the flow is artesian the works shall include proper capping and control valve to prevent the waste of ground water.

The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauges or an access port for measuring line, adequate to determine the water level elevation in the well at all times.

The water user shall maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the place of use described.

This certificate is issued to confirm changes in ADDITIONAL POINTS OF APPROPRIATION and PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered MARCH 25, 2022, at Special Order Volume 122, Page 624, approving Transfer Application T-13690, supersedes Certificate 94268, State Record of Water Right Certificates.
