confirms the right to the use of water perfected under the terms of Permit G-7182. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the well(s). The specific limits and conditions of the use are listed below.

SOURCE OF WATER: FOUR WELLS, TRIBUTARIES OF UMATILLA RIVER

PURPOSE OR USE: IRRIGATION OF 222.8 ACRES

MAXIMUM RATE: 2.79 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND (CFS); FURTHER LIMITED TO 0.66 CFS FROM WELL 1, 2.22 CFS FROM WELL 3 AND 2.79 CFS FROM WELL 4 AND WELL 5, IN ANY COMBINATION NOT TO EXCEED 2.79 CFS IN TOTAL.

DATE OF PRIORITY: FEBRUARY 25, 1977

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.



The water user shall maintain and operate the existing measurement devices and shall make such improvements as may be required by the Department.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
