confirms the right to the use of water perfected under the terms of Permit S-49909. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source. The specific limits and conditions of the use are listed below.

SOURCE: MILLS CREEK, A TRIBUTARY OF TULE LAKE

USE: IRRIGATION OF 0.65 ACRE

RATE: 0.016 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND

PRIORITY DATE: SEPTEMBER 8, 1986

The point of diversion is located as follows:

41 S	13 E	WM	7	NW SE	POD #1 - 1330 FEET NORTH AND 610 FEET EAST FROM S1/4 CORNER, SECTION 7

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

Water use measurement conditions:

- a) The water user shall maintain the totalizing flow meter, or other suitable measuring device, as approved by the Director, at each point of diversion, in good working order.
- b) The water user shall allow the Watermaster access to the meter or measuring device; provided however, where the meter or measuring device is located withing a private structure, the Watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

**NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW**

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.


By law, the land use associated with this water must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

The use of water allowed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including prior rights for maintaining instream flows.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered March 8, 2017 at Special Order Volume 104, Page 77, approving Transfer Application T-12358, and together with Certificate 92385, supersedes Certificate 86373, State record of Water Right Certificates.
