CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

L AND L FARM  
 PO BOX 611  
 ECHO, OR 97826

confirms the right to use the waters of COLUMBIA RIVER, JOHN DAY POOL, a tributary to PACIFIC OCEAN for the purpose of IRRIGATION OF 713.9 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-42856. The date of priority is JANUARY 11, 1978. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 15.76 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.


