Proposed use: Providing required stream flows for cutthroat, rainbow, brook and brown trout.

To be maintained in:

MIDDLE FORK ROGUE RIVER FROM BESSIE CREEK (SW1/4, SECTION 32, TOWNSHIP 32S, RANGE 4E WM); TO THE MOUTH (NW1/4, SECTION 9, TOWNSHIP 33S, RANGE 3E WM)

The right is established under Oregon Revised Statutes 537.341.

The date of priority is 5/5/1993.

The following conditions apply to the use of water under this certificate:

1. The right is limited to not more than the amounts, in cubic feet per second, during the time periods listed below:

2. The water right holder shall measure and report the in-stream flow along the reach of the stream or river described in the certificate as may be required by the standards for in-stream water right reporting of the Water Resources Commission.
3. For purposes of water distribution, this instream right shall not have priority over human or livestock consumption.
4. The instream flow allocated pursuant to this water right is not in addition to other instream flows created by a prior water right or designated minimum perennial stream flow.

5. The flows are to be measured at the lower end of the stream reach to protect necessary flows throughout the reach.
6. The instream water right will have no effect on and will not be enforceable against senior existing water rights of record authorized by the State of Oregon or any federal agency.
7. The establishment of an in-stream water right under the provisions of ORS 537.332 to 537.360 shall not take away or impair any permitted, certificated or decreed right to any waters or to the use of any waters vested prior to the date the in-stream water right is established pursuant to the provisions of ORS 537.332 to 537.360.
8. This instream water right certificate is issued pursuant to Application IS-73370 Final Order Incorporating Settlement Agreement, dated June 1, 2023.
9. The instream water right will have no call on water legally stored under a senior water right.
