confirms the right to the use of waters as limited and conditioned below. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the point(s) of diversion from the source.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Josephine County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 13, at Page 70.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposed aforesaid is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one cubic foot per second for each 50 acres of land irrigated during the irrigation season from April 1 to November 1 of each year.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of diversion described as follows:

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The water user shall maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted.

Water shall be acquired from the same surface water source as the original point of diversion.


The water user shall maintain a fish screen or fish by-pass device.

Said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree described, and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered August 9, 2004, at Special Order Volume 61, Page 58, approving Transfer Application T-9260, and together with Certificate 80885, supersedes Certificate 43598, State record of Water Right Certificates.
