CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to the use of water perfected under the terms of Permit S-46290. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the point(s) of diversion from the source. The specific limits and conditions of the use are listed below.

SOURCE: MEHL CREEK AND AN UNNAMED STREAM, TRIBUTARIES OF THE UMPQUA RIVER

USE: IRRIGATION OF 4.8 ACRES

RATE: 0.059 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND FROM MEHL CREEK WHEN AVAILABLE WITH ANY DEFICIENCY IN SUPPLY AT MEHL CREEK TO BE MADE UP BY DIVERSION OF WATER FROM THE UNNAMED STREAM

DATE OF PRIORITY: AUGUST 12, 1980

The point of diversion is located as follows:

23 S	8 W	WM	13	SW NE	POD 3 (UNNAMED STREAM) - 1435 FEET SOUTH AND 278 FEET EAST FROM N1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 14

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which the right is appurtenant is as follows:

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of diversion described as follows:


When required by the Department, the water user shall maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted.

The water user shall maintain a fish screen or fish by-pass device.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered December 20, 2018, at Special Order Volume 112 Page 120, approving Transfer Application T-12766, supersedes Certificate 84907, State record of Water Right Certificates.
