CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to the use of water perfected under the terms of Permit S-2346. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source. The specific limits and conditions of the use are listed below.

SOURCE: A SPRING

USE: DOMESTIC USE

MAXIMUM RATE: 0.018 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND

PRIORITY DATE: JANUARY 15, 1915

The authorized point of diversion is as follows:

29 S	12 W	WM	27	NW NW	880 FEET SOUTH AND 1280 FEET EAST OF NW CORNER OF SECTION 27

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to a ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent in case of rotation.

The use hereunder for irrigation shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, together with that diverted at the old point of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available from the original point of diversion described as follows:

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

Water use measurement conditions:

- a) The water user shall maintain the totalizing flow meter, or other suitable measuring device, as approved by the Director, at each new point of diversion, in good working order.
- b) The water user shall allow the Watermaster access to the meter or measuring device provided however, where the meter or measuring device are located within a private structure, the Watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

The water user shall operate and maintain the fish screen at the new point of diversion consistent with Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife's (ODFW) operational and maintenance standards.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.

Rights to the use of water for power purposes are limited to a period of forty years from the date of priority of the right, as herein set forth, subject to a preference right of renewal under the laws existing at the date the expiration of the right for power purposes, as hereby confirmed and limited.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered August 20, 2014, at Special Order Volume 93 Page 282, approving Transfer Application T-11662, and together with Certificate 89362, supersedes Certificate 6424, State record of Water Right Certificates.
