CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

WALTER R. IRWIN
HALFWAY, OR 97834

confirms the right to use the waters of the EAST PINE CREEK, a tributary of PINE CREEK for IRRIGATION of 30.0 ACRES AND STOCK USE.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Baker County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 11, at Page 235.

The date of priority is 1881.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed ONE- FORTIETH of a cubic foot per second per acre, measured at the point of diversion, and a total limitation of one acre-foot per second per acre, measured at the point of diversion, and a total limitation of one acre foot per acre during July, one acre foot per acre during August, and one-half acre foot per acre during September, of each year,

The point of diversion located as follows:



The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
