## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of THE ROGUE RIVER, a tributary of THE PACIFIC OCEAN for IRRIGATION of 54.4 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-18531. The date of priority is OCTOBER 28, 1948. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.342 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 4.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season FROM APRIL 2 TO OCTOBER 31 OF EACH YEAR.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
