This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 3, at Page 127. The date of priority is MAY 1909.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 2.18 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, subject to the provisions of paragraph 33 of said decree and all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
