- a) The water user shall maintain the totalizing flow meter, or, with prior approval of the Director, another suitable measuring device, at the new point of appropriation as approved by the Director, in good working order.
- b) The water user shall allow the Watermaster access to the meter or measuring devices; provided however, where the meter or measuring devices is located within a private structure, the Watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer (water source) as the original point of appropriation.
